

# b\_line<sup>2</sup> for Apprentices

**Did you know you could be in line for help with travel costs?**

This is because Derbyshire County Council and Derby City Councils' discount travel scheme b\_line has been extended.



Previously cut-price travel through b\_line was only for students in full-time education.

Now any young person, living in Derbyshire or Derby city, aged 16 up to their 19th birthday can get cheaper local bus and train fares too.

**But you'll need to apply for a b\_line2 card.**

You qualify for cut-price travel because Derbyshire County Council and Derby City Council pay the discounted part of your fare back to the bus or train operator.

But to get the cheaper fare you need to get a **b\_line2** card. Find out how at [www.derbyshire.gov.uk/b\\_line](http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/b_line)

Once you've got your card you'll be able to get 25% off full adult fares.

You'll be able to get the discount off most bus and train journeys in Derbyshire. Plus off some other services to nearby towns and cities providing your trip starts or finishes within the county.

Your **b\_line2** card will also get you discounts – typically 10% off – at 600 local shops and businesses.

And you can use it to borrow books, DVDs and use e-resources at all Derbyshire and Derby city libraries.
