# What is b\_line?

For those of you who are new to b\_line it is a travel, discount and library card scheme for all young people aged 11 up to 19th birthday living in Derbyshire and Derby city.

For those of you who've already had a b\_line card you should still read on – because for travel, a b\_line2 card gives you different discounts.

## TRAVEL

- Your b\_line2 card gets you 25% off full adult fares on local buses and trains. This is because Derbyshire County Council and Derby City Council pay this discount back to the operators on your behalf.
- b\_line2 cards are for travel 24/7.
- You can get the discount on most bus and train journeys within Derbyshire.
- And on some journeys to nearby towns and cities providing the trip starts or finishes in Derbyshire.
- You can't use b\_line2 for discounts on long distance coaches or special excursions.

## **DISCOUNTS**

## **LIBRARY**

Your b\_line2 card gives you library membership at all Derbyshire and Derby city libraries to borrow books, DVDs and e-resources. But first you need to get it activated.

So next time you visit your local library hand over your card to a member of staff and they'll register it for you.

If you lose or damage your card you can get a replacement for £5. Ask at school or go to [www.derbyshire.gov.uk/b\\_line](http://www.derbyshire.gov.uk/b_line) for more details on how to get one.

b\_line is only for young people living in Derbyshire and Derby city, although you can still get a card if you go to school outside the county. So, if you move you must return it to Derbyshire County Council (b\_line), County Hall, Matlock DE4 3AG.
